Rob has performed at over international international fringe festivals and won over twenty awards for his solo shows. He's won numerous poetry slams, including the Edinburgh Slam, BBC Two's Why Poetry Matters Slam, the Arts Council's Lit Up Slam and the Orlando Poetry Smackdown. He regularly appears on BBC radio and has shared stages with luminaries such as Harold Pinter, Sue Townsend, Jo Brand, Sarah Millican, Jimmy Carr, Russell Howard and Frankie Boyle.
